

ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT 2017-18

Honourable, Chief Guest , Maharani Mala Rajya Laxmi Shah, Member of Parliament, Tehri Lok Sabha Seat, President Shri. Rajnish Jayal , esteemed guests, parents, Ladies and gentlemen, my colleagues and dear students, a very good evening and warm welcome to one and all present here to grace the auspicious occasion of school's 51'nd Founders Day programme. It is a proud privilege for me to present before you the Annual Progress Report of the school for the session 2017-2018.

Founded in the year 1967 by a visionary and educationist Shri. F.R. Marshall, the school has come a long distance under the leadership, administration and educational vision of late Shri G.C. Juyal ,and the legacy is being carried forward by President Shri Rajnish Jayal president along with Shri Ratneesh Chandra Juyal, Chairman, board members and illustrious staff members.

The session 2017-18 started with the activities happening both at the Junior as well as senior section of the school. At the Jr. Section , the session started with the most solemn and prestigious ceremony , The INVESTITURE Ceremony, where the newly appointed Head boy Master Rakshit Gaur and Head Girl Miss Aahna Thapa took pledge along with the newly appointed Prefectorial Board of the Junior section. This was followed by a plethora of activities that highlighted the all round development of the student personality. Some of the activities were Inter House Flower arrangement competition, vegetable dressing contest, science and Art competitions and various other literary activities (Declamations, Debates, Elocution, Recitations , Storytelling etc. both in English and Hindi.).

Senior wing held its Investiture Ceremony in July, where the newly appointed Head Boy Master Ankit Rana and The Head Girl Miss Priyanka took pledge along with the newly appointed prefectorial Board. President Shri Rajnish Jayal, Shri Ratneesh Jayal, Chairman, Shri DN Thapliyal, Headmaster, senior teachers and students graced the occasion and blessed all newly appointed executives and other members.

We celebrated Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Birth Anniversary on 23rd January, Independence Day and Republic Day. On these Occasions, the President hoisted the flag, which was followed by series of patriotic songs, skit and dance performed by the students of both Jr. and Sr. Sections.

Teachers Day, Mother's Day and Many other festivals were celebrated by the students.

We celebrated the 52'nd Inter House Athletic Meet on 04 November 2018 . The meet was inaugurated by the chairman Shri Ratnish Jayal and the Chief Guest for the day was Shri Prakash Pant, Cabinet Minister, Uttarakhand Government. In the atheletic meet Overall

Championship Trophy was awarded to Ashoka House and the Overall Championship Runners Up trophy was awarded to Pratap House, March Past winner trophy was awarded to Shivaji House and the runners up trophy for march past was awarded to Pratap House. Best Athlete Boy for Senior Section was awarded to Ashish Negi of class Twelve; best athlete girl senior section was awarded to Kanishka Kumar of class Twelve. Best Athlete Boy , Junior Section was awarded to Rakshit Gaur of class six and best athlete girl junior section was awarded to Vanshika Tomar of class Six.. Brass Band of Mahar Regiment was a big attraction throughout the function in our Jogiwala sports complex.

On 10 October 2018, Marshall School organized the second ‘GC Juyal Inter School English Annual Debate’, on the topic “ Holding of simultaneous elections to the state legislative assembly and the Indian Parliament is not a feasible idea”. Around seventeen schools from Mussorie, Dehra Dun, Rishikesh and Haridwar took part in the debate. St. Joseph Academy, Dehra Dun team were declared Winners followed by DAV Public School, Dehra Dun team as Runners Up. Lt General GS Negi (Retd), Ex Commandant, Indian Military Academy was the Chief Guest and awarded prizes and certificates to the participants.

On 19'th November , 2018, the school hosted the prestigious All India F.R. Marshall Inter School English Debate Competition. Participants exhibited their oratory skills on the topic – “ Intense use of Social Media by teenagers harms their academic progress”. The winner trophy was awarded to Asian School , Dehra Dun and Kasiga School, Dehra Dun was awarded the runners up trophy. The prizes were given by Mr Rajnish Jayal, President , Marshall School Society, Dehra Dun. Marshall School, being the host school did not bid for the trophy but participated actively in the debate.

Carrying on with the tradition of cent percent result, once again we can proudly declare that the combined efforts of the educational community of the school bore fruits and we were able to come out with yet another hundred percent results in the ISC and ICSE results for the year 2017-2018. At ICSE level Master Vaibhav Ramola topped the school with aggregate of 97.2% percent marks followed by Miss Srishti Shankar 92.2%, Ayush Pant- 90.2%, Aditya Sahai – 90.26% , and Tushar Dimri – 90.2% marks. In Computer Science 17 students scored above ninety percent marks; whereas in Hindi subject 23 students scored above ninety percent marks.

In Class XII (ISC Board Examinations) Master PEEYUSH P Singh topped the school with an aggregate of 91 % marks, followed by Miss Anjali Rana – 90.5 % , Miss Shrishti Rawat – 90.5% and Kritika Bansal – 90.25 % marks. It is a matter of great honour for us to inform you about the selection of the following students in different streams. Rithik Mahawar cleared IIT Advance Examination, Akriti Badola cleared NEET Medical Examination; she was also the over all topper in the Prestigious GB Pant Nagar University. Pankaj Rawat an ex student of Marshall School became a Lieutenant in the Indian Army after

completing his course from the prestigious Indian Military Academy Dehra Dun.

Ladies and Gentlemen, all these achievements and activities highlighted in the Report have been possible due to the diligence and untiring efforts of the staff and students of our school. I owe special thanks to the faculty members of our school. The parents have been a pillar of strength in all our endeavours. My sincere thanks to them for their continuous support and encouragement.
