

## Marshall School , organizes science exhibition.

To mark the birth anniversary of Sir CV Raman, Nobel Laurette , who invented the Ramman Effect , and celebrated in India as National Science Day, Marshall School, Dehra Dun organized a Science and Art Exhibition, here today.
